Mr. Bartz's professional career spans 35 years of working in the natural gas pipeline transmission industry. He was also the Project Director of the Cheniere's 42" Creole Trail Pipeline which was constructed to transport regasified LNG from Cheniere's Sabine Pass terminal to numerous interstate gas transmission companies.
